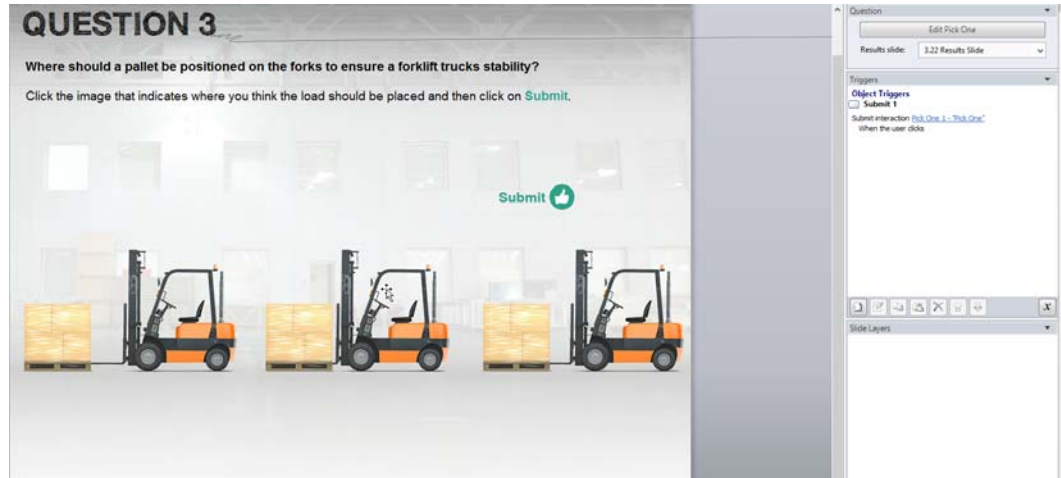
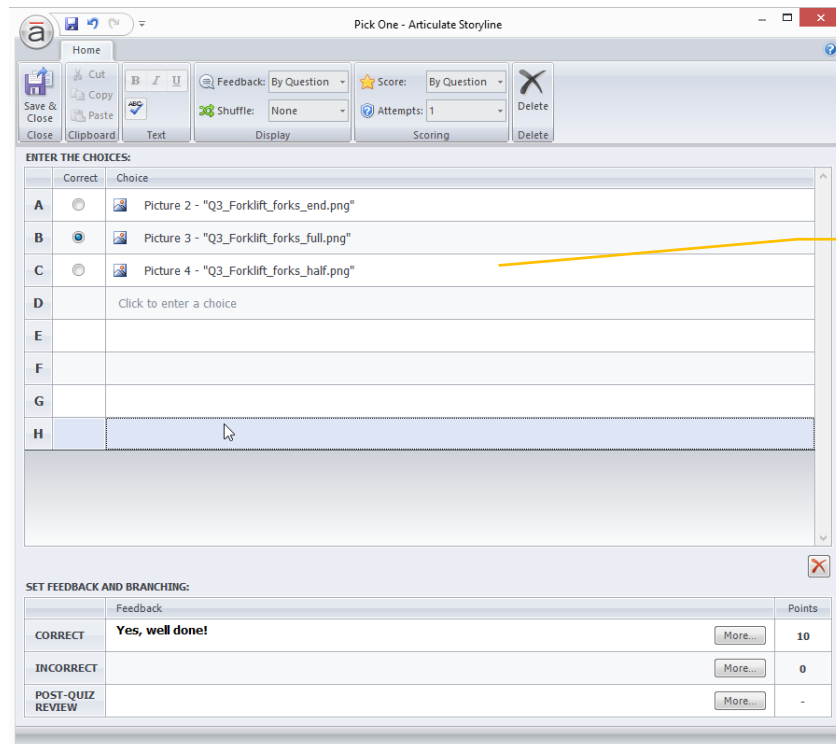


Example of Graphical MCQ Editor in Storyline



The edit button pops up the editor



The items are listed in the main content area – which scrolls depending on how many items are added, so no limits around the design space. The Component properties / feedback are fixed in the top and bottom bars.

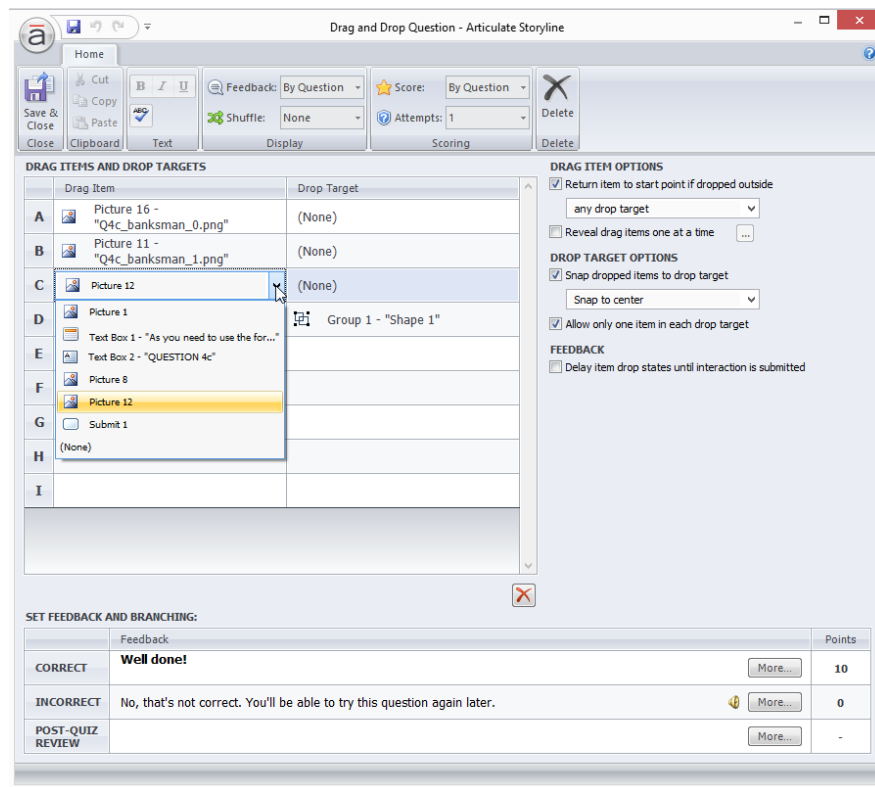

In this case there are 2 columns of items – drag item and target item. Again the items are listed in a scrollable main window so you can add as many as you like with component properties top and bottom and item specific properties to the side.



The main item property – in this case the image can once again be selected from a drop down in the list – so the way you edit the key property i.e. the image is consistent with other component types but additional properties are edited in the right hand panel.
