

Accessibility testing

Tested with IE11 and NVDA

Personal suggestions:

- When the user doesn't select any answer and clicks submit he should get a response
- Matching Components: Explain how the user can select an answer (arrow down and up key)
- Media Components: Explain that the user can pause the video by clicking the play button again
- Menu items progress bars: Make the progress bar from the menu items accessible so users know if they have already completed/started the topic
- Page Level Progress: When navigating through the components in the page level progress it might be good to know if the components have already been completed.
- Ecs Key: Tell the user that he is in the top navigation bar every time he clicks the ecs key. At the moment this text is just played the first time you click the button
- Graphics: It's not possible to select/focus an image. This might be necessary to read the alt text of an image

Bugs:

- The show feedback label doesn't seem to work. That's especially a problem when you close the feedback pop up and you don't know where you are
- Trickle (known issue): After clicking on "continue to next question" the focus jumps to the top of the page and not to the next question
- Page "Adapt comes with some plugins too": When the user selects answers and clicks on submit the text "not available" is read
- Page "Welcome to Adapt Learning": There is an empty headline above the video
- It's not possible to turn on the accessibility when a feedback popup is open. Without using the mouse it's impossible to navigate away
